Your e-mail communications to Lawrence DiGiovanna, Chair of the Grievance Committee for the Second and Eleventh Judicial Districts, have been referred to my office for action and reply. They will be treated as a request by you to have this court review the Grievance Committee's dismissal of your complaint against Steven C. Krane.
