Alan,

It was good speaking again with you today regarding your representation of Iviewit. Both P. Stephen Lamont and myself appreciate the review that you have begun since it was agreed last week with Krishna to have you undertake our representation. It was the Companies understanding that Schiffrin and Barroway last week under their contract obligations of the Letter of Understanding with Iviewit, had through Krishna, chose you to represent the Company, as you were his relative and could move quickly. When we all spoke you and Krishna mentioned that you had worked out the fee arrangements and were deferring the first year for a year on Schiffrin & Barroway's promise to pay and your personal relationship.
