On September 3, 2010, the Office of the Chief Inspector General received your email complaint in which you requested an investigation concerning alleged criminal violations and corruption within several agencies, the Florida Bar, and Florida courts. In addition, you requested that your complaint be investigated by the Florida Grand Jury.

Please be advised that this office has no authority to conduct investigations of alleged criminal violations and has no jurisdiction over private companies, local government entities, judges or judicial matters, or the Florida Bar.

In Florida, the responsibility to conduct statewide grand juries is given to the Statewide Prosecutor. We will forward your complaint information to the Statewide Prosecutor for consideration.
