As Mark Cuban continues his battle against the Securities and Exchange Commission, the federal regulatory agency could be facing a battle of its own in Washington, D.C.

<u>MarketWatch says the SEC is facing tough questioning</u> in Washington over allegations that the regulator's Fort Worth office knew something was amiss at Stanford Financial Group as early as 1997.

Houston-based Stanford Financial Group operated a wealth management office in the Crescent office building in Uptown Dallas. On Feb. 17, 2009, the SEC's Fort Worth office accused Stanford Financial, company founder R. Allen Stanford and other executives of fraud. The complaint alleged that the Stanford companies managed to sell approximately \$8 billion in so-called "certificates of deposit" to investors, but those funds were instead directed to other sorts of investment.

The MarketWatch report says the inspector general testified Wednesday saying the SEC is "still focused too much on the number of cases it has brought and not enough on the number of investors protected."
