
This Cause came before the Court upon April 4, 2025 at 10:00am upon the Court's Order to Show Cause directed towards Kevin R. Hall (DE #343). At the date and time fixed by this Court for hearing, Mr. Hall failed to appear. Mr. Hall filed an untimely statement of good cause which this Court has nevertheless reviewed. In it, Mr. Hall, purportedly with the aid of AI software, continues to reargue points of law that have already been decided adversely to him. He refers to himself as *pro se* *Intervenor* despite this Court denying his request to intervene. Furthermore, a portion of his "good cause" consists of blaming the Court for not "hearing from" certain witnesses during the hearing on the Motion to Set Aside the Settlement agreement despite these witnesses not being called, or attempted to be called, by either side. Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED**

Due to Kevin R. Hall's repeated, frivolous filings lacking legal merit which are abusing the scarce judicial resources of this Court, the Clerk of Court is directed to Court to no longer accept any paper filed by Kevin R. Hall – eservice emails kh.itconsultingsalesoffices@gmail.com

and krh.itconsulting@gmail.com, unless the document has been reviewed and signed by a member in good standing of the Florida Bar who certifies that a good faith basis exists for each claim presented. *Rivas v. Bank of New York Mellon*, 239 So. 3d 614 (Fla. 2018); *State v. Spencer*, 751 So. 2d 47, 48 (Fla. 1999); *Testa v. Testa*, 171 So. 3d 244 (Fla. 4th DCA 2015).
