**ORDER GRANTING IN PART MOTION AND EXTENDING
DEADLINE TO CORRECT FILING DEFICIENCIES**

This matter came before the Court upon the filing of the pro se Debtor's *Motion to Extend Time to File Required Information Pursuant to 11 USC Section 521a* (Doc. 15) (the "Motion to Extend"). The Motion to Extend seeks an extension of the April 28, 2025, deadline imposed by the *Notice of Incomplete Filings* (Doc. 5) ("Deficiency Notice"). Upon review, the Court finds good cause to grant the Motion to Extend in part. Therefore, the Court **ORDERS**:

1. The Motion to Extend (Doc. 15) is **GRANTED** in part.
2. The Debtor has through and including May 12, 2025, to correct all filing deficiencies detailed in the Deficiency Notice.
3. Further extensions will be granted only after a hearing and only upon a showing of exceptional circumstances.

Eliot Bernstein, the Debtor herein, respectfully shows this Court as follows:

1. I am the Debtor Pro Se.
2. I make this motion under Rule Number 1007-1 (B) Extension of Time to File Lists, Schedules, Statements and Other Required Documents and Local Rule Number Rule 9013-1 based on Medical Emergency and good cause.
3. From what I can tell this case began with Chief Judge Erik Kimball and then transferred to Judge Mindy A. Mora but may now be assigned to Hon. Judge Peter D. Russin.

4. I am aware that certain Lists and Schedules were required to be filed by this day April 28, 2025 Notice of Incomplete Filings Due . Chapter 13 Plan due by 4/28/2025. Summary of Your Assets and Liabilities and Certain Statistical Information due 4/28/2025. Schedules A-J due 4/28/2025. Statement of Financial Affairs Due 4/28/2025. Declaration Concerning Debtors Schedules Due: 4/28/2025. Chapter 13 Statement of Your Current Monthly Income and Calculation of Commitment Period Form 122C-1 Due 4/28/2025. Payment Advices due for Debtor 4/28/2025. [Incomplete Filings due by 4/28/2025]. (Thompson, Luctricia) (Entered: 04/14/2025).
5. To the best of my knowledge the Creditor's Meeting is now based on an Amended Notice of Chapter 13 Case and Meeting of Creditors. Meeting of Creditors to be Held on 5/21/2025 at 09:00 AM at www.Zoom.us - Weiner: Meeting ID 641 184 3541, Passcode 9807786714, Phone (954) 399-6624.
6. I was admitted to University of Miami on 4/18/25 through 4/22/25 for Congestive Heart Disease, Pulmonary Edema and Heart Failure.
7. I was released under Cardiac Care and am required to go to Cardiac Rehab over the next several weeks to prepare for the long overdue Triple Bypass.
8. In addition to the 4 days I was hospitalized for Congestive Heart Failure I was unavailable for most any activity in the day before I was admitted due to

these conditions and thus directly lost at least 5 of the 14 days to submit the Schedules due to direct medical emergency.

9. I virtually collapsed on the steps of the Bankruptcy Court due to congestive heart failure when filing this Bankruptcy Petition on April 14, 2025 which was filed in good faith.
10. I am still under heavy medication and have limited hours in any day that I can be engaged to complete the required forms.
11. I was also under dental care and treatment for oral surgeries and complications during these 2 weeks and am on muscle and pain medicine.
12. In fact, in the hospital I was informed I had to take care of the dental and oral surgery care to prevent risk of infection for the upcoming heart surgery.
13. I have already downloaded all of the required forms and have started all of the forms and have completed several forms as attached.
14. These forms are regarding Executory Contracts, Declaration of Payment Advices and Schedule A-B Property.
15. The emergency medical conditions should be sufficient cause for a brief and reasonable extension to file the required Lists and Schedules.
16. There is other good cause for an extension as well.
17. Years ago I was directed by Harry Moatz who was the the Director of the OED of the USPTO to file "Fraud against the United States" in relation to

attorneys who had stolen my Intellectual Properties valued in the hundreds of billions of dollars by Leading Experts from Lockheed Martin, the Intel Corp. and others as my own attorneys were placing Patents in their own names or names other than myself and companies.

18. In fact I only found out about some of the wrongful actions against my IP by learning an Involuntary Bankruptcy was filed in this very US Bankruptcy Court of the Southern District of Florida against my companies.
19. Attorney Bradley Shraiberg was involved in those affairs.
20. I continue to provide information to a DC based contact on all of my cases in the State Courts and these Bankruptcy Court proceedings and as early as October of 2013 had notified the State Court of Judge Martin Colin that Ted Bernstein and Tescher and Spallina were improperly using the private Note with Walter and Pat Sahm for the real estate where I live as an extortionate tool against me threatening foreclosure to extract improper settlement when monies from the Estates and Trusts of my parents Simon and Shirley Bernstine were supposed to pay off the \$100K private Note to the Sahms which was done as part of Asset Protection for my benefit and the benefit of my family.
21. I have asserted and maintain Florida Constitution Homestead Protection as to my percentage of the real property that relates to the Secured Creditors


but informed the State Court I do not see the Tax exemptions that may come with Homestead protection.

22. Within 4 days of my filing in my prior Bankruptcy under Case Number 23-12630-PDR under DE No. 20 in that case filed 4-13-23 exposing frauds a Guardianship proceeding was commenced against Pat Sahm, Sr who is the only true and proper Secured Creditor in the case.
23. Litigation of the propriety of any Guardianship and related frauds are open in that State Court case and recently my former attorney Inger Garcia was alleged to be involved in fraud on the Court in the foreclosure case causing conflicts which have impacted my ability to retain attorneys.
24. There is adequate protection to the Secured Creditor and a Zillow estimate of the real estate value of the property as of today is over \$800,000.00.
25. AI Chatgpt has suggested an Adversary proceeding may be proper in this case and I am seeking an attorney for that filing and to even represent me in this case.
26. More than sufficient assets can be available or should be from the Trusts and Estates of my parents Simon and Shirley for a proper settlement with Pat Sahm, Sr that is not mired in conflicts and frauds.
27. The Trustee and US Trustee are being served this motion under Local Rule 9013(1)(c)(2).

28. I request an extension of at least 7 to 14 days which is still sufficiently in advance of the present Notice for the Meeting of Creditors but at least ask for some reasonable time as determined by the Court.

WHEREFORE, it is respectfully prayed for an Order granting an extension of time to file the Lists and Schedules in a reasonable time based on medical emergency and good cause and for such other and further relief as may be just and proper.
