Joanna Sahm has breached her fiduciary duties both as a Power of Attorney for her mother and as PR of her father's estate. These breaches have caused harm and damages to those she was trusted by but also by litigants in court cases through fraud.

Joanna, participated in a foreclosure case where as PR of her father's estate, she failed to notify the court of his death as a Plaintiff and continued to file over two years after his death as if he was alive. Defendants had no idea her father died as he was not substituted out as required and instead he filed for Summary Judgment 6 months after death and gained a Final Judgment in his name a year after his death. Two years after he was dead he also filed in a Federal BK case through Joanna. In the federal court when she finally was exposed she substituted the estate of her father for her dead father and sent litigants to find the estate lawyer who after reaching settlement Joanna rejected, informed opposing counsel that when he looked at the inventory he did not find the note and thus was her father's estate really was not a party.

As for fiducial responsibilities using her mother's Power of Attorney, she filed years of filings in court without submitting the POA and identifying herself acting in such capacity, she just participated as if she was her mother. Her mother's sworn statement shows she had no idea what her daughter was doing or who the counsel she had that were representing her without identifying they were doing so with a POA.

Joanna Sahm when confronted with her fraud in court now wants to us the GA court as a weapon to silence her mother from testifying as a witness in both the foreclosure case and a felony case, she has pending over her sister, who pulled an unloaded gun on her. Joanna has provided no accountings of the estate or trusts of her father to her mother or sister. Joanna Sahm cannot be a Guardian or have any further fiducial control over her ever from these events.
