MONDAY JUNE 27, 2005, AT APPROXIMATELY 0630 HOU  
RES UNDED THE FAMILY AUTOMOTIVE SHOP AT 1255 SOU  
MILI RY TR, BOYNTON BCH, TO INVLSITIGATE AN AU BU  
LARY

THE MANAGER AT FAMILY AUTOMOTIVE SAID THAT HE ARRIVE  
AT WORK AT 0630 HOURS AND DISCOVERED BERNSTEIN'S VAN WITH  
THE DOORS LEFT OPEN AND NOTICED THAT THE CONSOLE HAD BEEN  
BROKEN APART AND THE RADIO STOLEN, AS WELL AS TH OVERHEAD  
DVD PLAYER HAVING BEEN REMOVED. HE EXPLAINED THAT HE LEFT  
WORK AT APPROX 1700 HOURS ON FRIDAY, JUNE 24TH, AND THAT  
BERNSTEIN'S VEHICLE WAS DELIVERED SOMETIME AFTER THAT

THE KEYS TO BERNSTEIN'S VEHICLE WERE LEFT ON THE BACK  
SEAT ON THE FLOOR OF THE BACKSEAT, I FOUND A KEY FOR A TOYOTA  
AND, AFTER PROCESSING IT FOR DNA SAMPLES, I DISCOVERED THAT  
IT BELONGED TO THE VEHICLE NEXT TO BERNSTEIN'S, A BEIGE  
TOYOTA V6LE, FL TAG JOOJEY, BELONGING TO A JANNETH COUMBS,  
OF 144 SE 31ST AV IN BOYNTON BCH. I CHECKED COUMBS VEHICLE  
AND IT WAS UNDISTURBED WITH THE DOORS SECURED. I ALSO  
RETRIEVED DNA SAMPLES FROM THE OVERHEAD DVD SCREEN AS WL  
AS THE RADIO CONSOLE. PRIOR TO OBTAINING THE DNA SAMPLE

FROM THE DVD SCREEN, I ATTEMPTED TO LIFT LATENT PRINTS WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS. UNDERNEATH THE REAR SEAT, I FOUND A PAIR OF WIRE CUTTERS AND RETRIEVED DNA SAMPLES FROM IT AS WELL. I SUBMITTED THE WIRE CUTTERS ALONG WITH THE DNA SAMPLES TO EVIDENCE.

I MET WITH CANDICE BERNSTEIN AT HER RESIDENCE AT 10150 STONEDENCE CIR, APT 001, AND SHE INFORMED ME THAT HER VEHICLE WAS DELIVERED TO THE FAMILY AUTOMOTIVE AT 1900 HOURS ON FRIDAY, JUNE 24TH. SHE ALSO SAID SHE HAD NO IDEA WHO MAY HAVE BROKEN INTO HER VEHICLE AND CANNOT PROVIDE ANY SUSPECT INFORMATION.
